




A Journey from Offline to Online

Academic Excellence and Curriculum Breadth Pre-Primary

The Pre-Primary wing of the school comprises of classes **Nursery to Prep** and caters to the needs of early childhood development. The environment here is child friendly. The **classrooms are colourful** and located in the junior wing where they tend to learn social skills, develop verbal ability and imbibe the skills and joy of creativity through art and craft. The integral parts of the curriculum are - recognition, reading and writing of the Hindi and English letters and basic arithmetical concepts.

Primary (I to V)

At this level, children are exposed to formal academics.

The young ones are expected to spend more time in activities that enhance their cognitive, emotional, social, physical and motor development. For this group 'Learning by Doing' is the approach.



Middle (VI to VIII)

The school puts equal emphasis on both curricular and co-curricular activities. Curriculum follows CBSE guidelines and co-curricular activities include Socially Useful & Productive Work (S.U.P.W.) & Physical and Health Education.

Secondary (IX & X)

In class IX & X children are geared to focus on academics to do well in board exam. However, the school understands the importance of continuing with art, craft and music for all-round development.

Assessment / Evaluation

Cbse has suggested a new evaluation pattern which aims to boost competency-based education. The academic session is moduled according to New Education Policy which aims at an inclusive, participatory and holistic approach, however particularly emphasising on the development of the creative potential of each individual. It is based on the principle that education must develop the 'Foundational Capacities' of Literacy and Numeracy and 'High-Order Cognitive Capacities', such as critical thinking and problem solving and also Social, Ethical, and Emotional Capacities and Dispositions. The pattern will include periodic assessment, internal assessment/project work/practical and theory exam.

Co-curricular Activities

House System

To help students to excel in personal and professional skills through co-curricular activities, the total student strength of the school is divided into four houses; Rani Lakshmi Bai, Padmavati, Sarojini Naidu and Vijaya Lakshmi. Inter - house competitions teach them tolerance and team work, aesthetics and creativity, reading and writing besides getting improved in various sports and indoor games. Each house has teacher mentors, a student captain and a vice - captain.

Literary Activities:

Various co-curricular activities are conducted through inter house competitions such as Debate, Extempore, Elocution, Group discussion, Quiz, Essay Writing, Poem recitation, Sanskrit Shloka recitation, Thought presentation, Declamation etc.

Art & Craft Activities:

In order to enhance the aesthetic skills of the students various creative activities are conducted such as Best out of waste, Mehendi layout, Gift wrapping, Rangoli making, Card & Bookmarks making, Paper cutting & folding, Face painting, Collage making, Drawing & Painting, Poster making etc.

Cultural Activities:

Various cultural activities are conducted throughout the year such as Solo & Group dance, Solo & Group song, Skit, Fashion show, Fancy dress, Pantomime, Drama, etc. The school also organizes and sends students for various interschool competitions like Debate, Dance and Quiz etc. This is done in order to install confidence and help them have a better world view.

An integrated science lab with all essential equipments, instruments, specimen, models, charts etc. is accessible to children.


Library

School's music room has keyboards, Guitars, Tabla set, Harmonium, Drum sets, Violins, Congo and Octopods etc.


• E-Learning:

Withdrawal

- 1. Parents willing to shift their ward from Vidyawadi should intimate us latest by 31st Jan. of the current academic session.
- 2. To avail the T.C. you are requested to put in an application at least 7 days in advance in the prescribed form along with the prescribed fee.

Conveniences

- 1. Please go through the prospectus carefully.
- 2. Any concern regarding your child should be given in written format to the school Principal along with proper details of the student.
- 3. For enquiry, adhere to our office time on week days between 11.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m. only.
- 4. You can meet the school Principal on week days between 10.00 a.m. to 11.00 a.m. only.
- 5. To avoid inconvenience, change in address or phone no. should be registered with the school office at the earliest.
- 6. In an academic year 75% attendance is compulsory for a student.
- 7. Students can remain absent only with sanctioned leave.
- 8. For emergency, the child is allowed out of the school only with one of the parent or guardian. This is crucial for the safety of the child.
- Reporting of the student on the opening day is compulsory.
- 10. Parents are responsible for the loss of classroom learning during long absenteeism.
- 11. Co-curricular activities are integral to school syllabus. Participation is compulsory.
- 12. Parents are expected to sign and follow the school diary and test papers regularly.
- 13. Parents are requested to attend all the PTMs to have first hand information about their child's progress. However, PTMs conducted after half yearly and annual exams are compulsory for parents to attend as in this meeting the progress report of the child is handed over to them.
- 14. No student is allowed to carry cell phones/I-pods/MP3 players to the school. If found, a fine of Rs.1000/- will be imposed and strict disciplinary action will be taken.




